The Veterans Home of California – Ventura is a 60-bed, long-term Residential Care Facility, also known as “assisted living.” The Veterans Home opened in December, 2010. The Veterans Home provides California Veterans with a living environment that protects their dignity and contributes to their feeling of self-reliance and self-worth.

Residents at this level of care require minimal assistance, and supervision with some activities of daily living. Services may include care by licensed nurses.

The Veterans Home offers an enhanced plan of amenities, including:

- Room and board – three meals plus snacks
- Assistance with medical and dental services
- Assistance with medications
- A modern fitness center and exercise classes
- Library, cable television, and wireless Internet
- Restaurant dining experience
- Dietary modifications
- Housekeeping and laundry services
- Caring and compassionate staff, and
- Transportation to medical appointments and off-campus activities
- A variety of community outings and an enhanced activity program

The Ventura Veterans Home is located near the gleaming California Pacific Ocean coastline, about an

hour’s drive northwest of Los Angeles, 35 miles south of Santa Barbara and a few short minutes off U.S. Highway 101. The United States Naval Base Ventura County is located close by.

Ventura and nearby Oxnard, California offer many cultural and educational opportunities for Veterans Home residents and their families to enjoy, including the Ventura County Fairgrounds, Ventura Harbor Village, Oxnard Heritage Square, the nearby harbors areas of Ventura, Oxnard, Port Hueneme and the Channel Islands – as well as California’s historic Missions and Adobes, golf courses, museums, lovely parks and shopping centers.

Veterans Homes of California are also located in Barstow, Chula Vista, Lancaster, West Los Angeles, and Yountville. Veterans Homes are currently under construction in Fresno and Redding. Veterans considering assisted living are encouraged to apply to any of the Veterans Homes of California. Spouses are also eligible to apply with the Veteran.
