SUBJECT: COLLEGE TUITION FEE WAIVER PROGRAM

In accordance with the provisions of the California Education Code §66025.3(c), the new income limit for otherwise eligible students under **Plan "B"**, for the school academic year (AY) 2016-2017 is \$12,331.

Use this \$12,331 figure in determining all **Plan "B"** awards.

Plan "B" awards for AY 2016-2017 **MUST** accompany an income tax return for calendar year 2015 or a statement from the Internal Revenue Service or Franchise Tax Board that verifies that a return was not filed for tax year 2015.
