SUBJECT: COLLEGE TUITION FEE WAIVER PROGRAM

In accordance with the provisions of the California Education Code §66025, the new income limit for otherwise eligible students under **Plan "B"**, for the school academic year (AY) 2015-2016 is \$12,316.

Use this \$12,316 figure in determining all **Plan "B"** awards.

**Plan "B"** awards for AY 2015-2016 MUST accompany an income tax return for calendar year 2014 or a statement from the Internal Revenue Service or Franchise Tax Board that verifies that a return was not filed for tax year 2014.
