SUBJECT: COLLEGE TUITION FEE WAIVER PROGRAM

In accordance with the provisions of the California Education Code §66025, the new income limit for otherwise eligible students under Plan "B", for the school academic year (AY) 2013-2014 is \$11,945.

Use this \$11,945 figure in determining all Plan "B" awards.

Plan "B" awards for AY 2013-2014 must accompany an income tax return for calendar year 2012 or a statement from the Internal Revenue Service or Franchise Tax Board that verifies that a return was not filed for tax year 2012.
