SUBJECT: COLLEGE TUITION FEE WAIVER PROGRAM

In accordance with the provisions of the California Education Code §66025, the new income limit for otherwise eligible students under Plan "B", for the school academic year (AY) 2014-2015 is \$12,119.

Use this \$12,119 figure in determining all Plan "B" awards.

Plan "B" awards for AY 2014-2015 MUST accompany an income tax return for calendar year 2013 or a statement from the Internal Revenue Service or Franchise Tax Board that verifies that a return was not filed for tax year 2013.
